This sculpture of a dog was made by the artist Karl Duldig using clay. Timmy was the Duldig family's border-collie and lived with them at their home in East Malvern, now a house museum. There are many sculptures of animals to be discovered in our museum. You can even find some in the artists studio that Karl built and worked from 1962 – 1986.

Colour or decorate Timmy →

Look at the photo of Timmy above, can you see the texture in the clay?

Do you think Timmy's fur is smooth or shaggy?

This artist has coloured the clay using glaze which is like a glassy paint that is applied and then cooked in a special oven called a kiln for it to harden.
